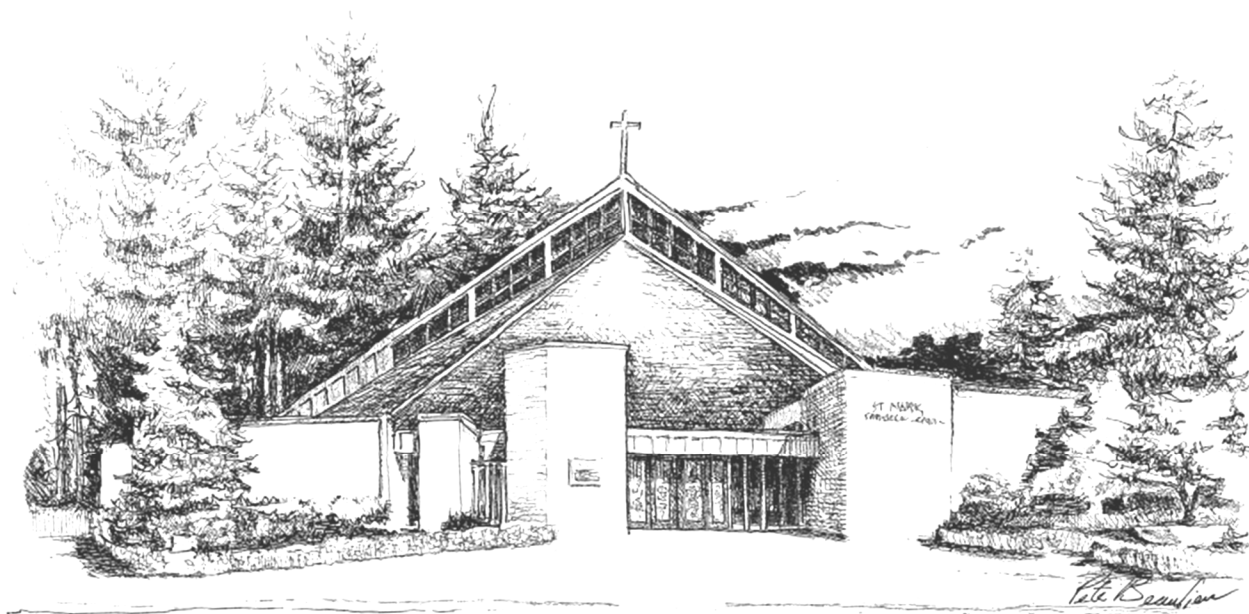

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Look to your covenant, O Lord, and forget not the life of your poor ones for ever.
Arise, O God, and defend your cause, and forget not the cries of those who seek you. Cf. Ps 74 (73): 20, 19, 22, 23

Today's Gospel is an immediate follow-up to the feeding of the five thousand of last Sunday's reading. If that wasn't wondrous enough, Jesus steps it up quite literally, as He walks across the water. But what's the point?

The problem we consistently find in our encounter with Jesus is that we focus on the miracles rather than the One behind them. Jesus observes this Himself, saying "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate for loaves and were filled" (John 6:26)

Jesus doesn't perform miracles as an end in themselves, nor even to call attention to Himself. Jesus is interested in one thing only: intimate friendship with each and every one of us.

It's natural to wonder at the image of Christ walking on the water, but if we were to stop at the spectacle we would miss the punchline: Jesus' invitation to Peter to join Him.

We, too, are invited to join ourselves to Him. His desire is to be inseparably united with us forever! Forgiveness of sin, the changing of bread & wine to His Body & Blood, the resurrection of the dead - these serve a singular purpose: to help us respond even more perfectly than Peter and come to Him.

Tomorrow, August 10th, is the **feast of Saint Lawrence**. A Christian in the third century, he was born into a time of great persecution of the faith.



Emperor Valerian demanded the deacon to give him the Church's wealth. Lawrence brought to him the poor of the city, presenting them as the greatest treasure of the Church.

Angered, the emperor condemned Lawrence to execution by fire. Even in death, he was of good humor, declaring 'turn me over, I'm well done on this side'.

Lawrence, patron of the poor, pray for us!

Next week I will be writing an update letter to share the latest developments in the archdiocese and at Saint Mark parish. I will also be offering some thoughts about what we might do as a community even as the pandemic restrictions continue. Part of that reflection will be an invitation to you to participate in determining what would be most helpful - and how we might work together to implement your ideas.

Some questions for to help our prayerful discernment:

- **what community opportunities would be most beneficial for Saint Mark?**
- and
- **how can each of us help make those opportunities possible?**

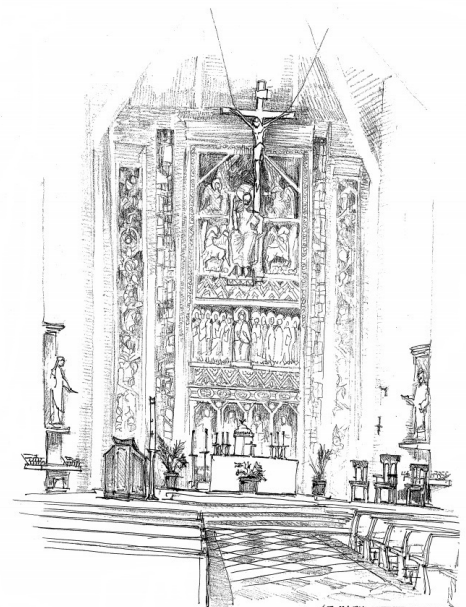

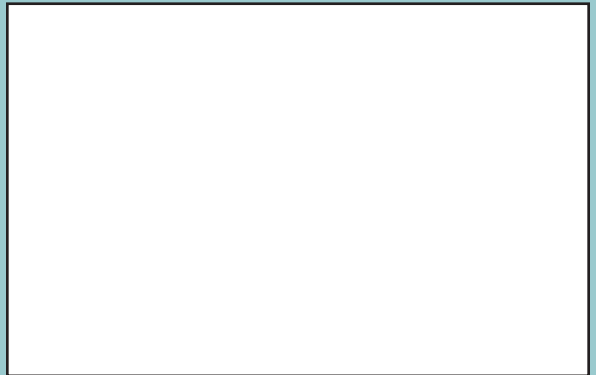

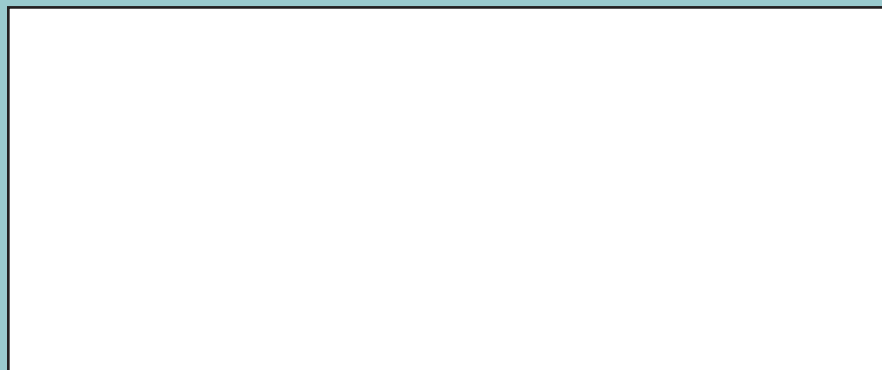
