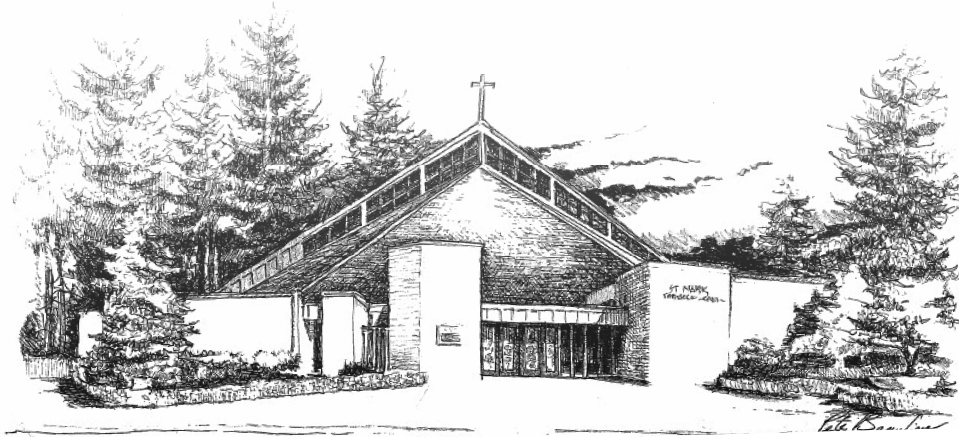

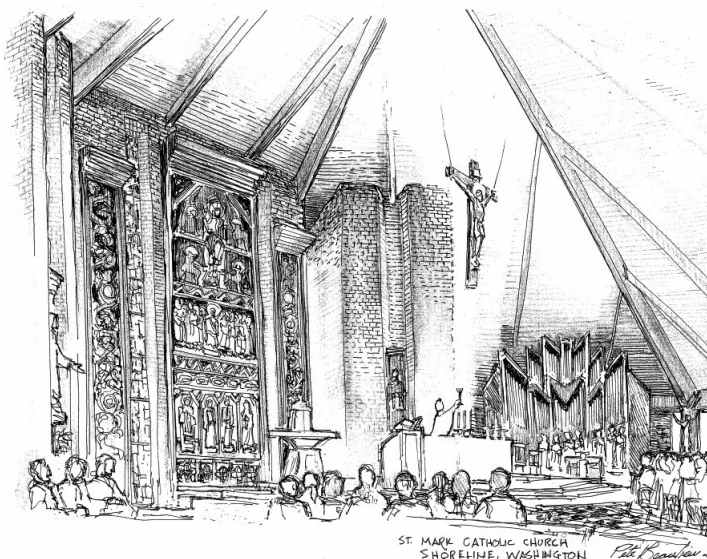

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

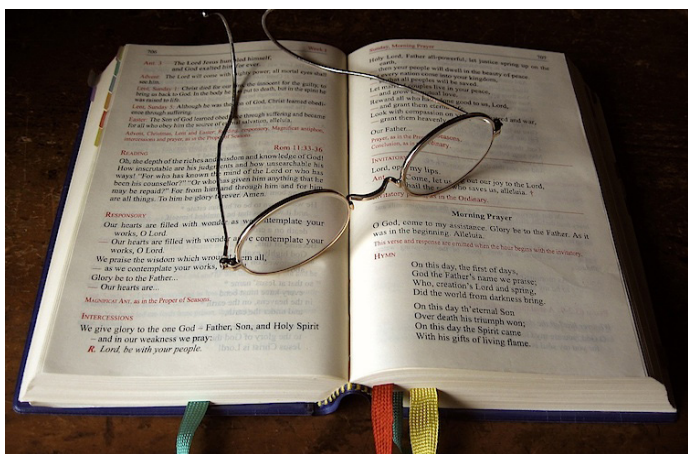

Let my prayer come into your presence. Incline your ear to my cry for help, O Lord.

Cf. Ps 88 (87): 3

Today's responsorial psalm - **psalm 62** - happens to be the first psalm of the Sunday of Morning Prayer of the first week of the four-week psalter in the Liturgy of the Hours. Moreover, nearly every time there is a feast or solemnity, Morning Prayer of Sunday Week I is prayed, returning us to this psalm. If you are in the habit of praying the Liturgy of the Hours, you probably have psalm 62 memorized:

“O God, you are my God whom I seek; for you my flesh pines and my soul thirsts like the earth, parched, lifeless and without water.”



We do thirst for God, body and soul! How often we find that, even after having filled ourselves with entertainment, good food, and surrounded by rich possessions, we still feel empty inside. These things, though good, can not fill the God-sized gap in our lives.

Perhaps to our surprise, God thirsts for us and pines for our presence and affection! Let us take the time to go to Him, in prayer and in the sacraments, that we may find fulfillment.



This Wednesday (November 11), we celebrate **Veterans Day** in the United States.

Originally marking the end of World War I with the Armistice of Germany (taking place at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918), Armistice Day was renamed Veterans Day in 1954. Veterans Day celebrates the service of all United States military veterans.

May we take the time to personally thank the veterans in our lives and offer prayers of gratitude for their service to our country.

November 9 is the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. Though the most icon church of Rome is Saint Peter's basilica, the cathedral of the pope is the Lateran Basilica (formally titled “Cathedral of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and the Evangelist in the Lateran”).

The oldest of the four major basilicas, the Lateran Basilica is a symbol of unity in the Church, centered around the Vicar of Christ, the pope. Today let us pray for Pope Francis and the Church.

It's Okay Not to be Okay: Part IV

What is stigma?

Stigma is a mark of disgrace or shame. There are four common components: Labeling someone with a condition; stereotyping people who have that condition creating a division (a superior “us” group and a devalued “them” group) resulting in loss of status; discriminating against someone on the basis of a label.

Confronting Stigma

“In my family, there was mental illness but I never knew it. My grandfather had actually died by suicide in the 1930’s, long before I was born, but nobody in the family ever talked about it. I had two aunts who occasionally would go on extended vacations that nobody really talked about—they were going for treatment. Just the fact that my family never talked about the past was due to the stigma. And I think that’s an issue for people today still. The stigma is so great and they say that’s one of the issues why people don’t get help for either themselves or for their loved ones. They feel they will be judged.”

A fundamental truth is that each human being is created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26-27) and the Catholic Church unconditionally embraces and faithfully proclaims this truth. It is the foundation for human dignity.

At times we unwittingly act or speak in ways that devalue people with mental health conditions. We all can and should be advocates for those experiencing mental health issues and we can be vigilant in our efforts to treasure each person as a member of the Body of Christ.

The cost of the stigma of mental illness is great to those who suffer from these conditions, those who care for them, and our society. Although effective treatments exist, nearly two thirds of the adults with these conditions do not seek treatment because of the fear of negative consequences should their treatment become known. Lack of treatment can result in pressure on marriages, families, friends and relationships.

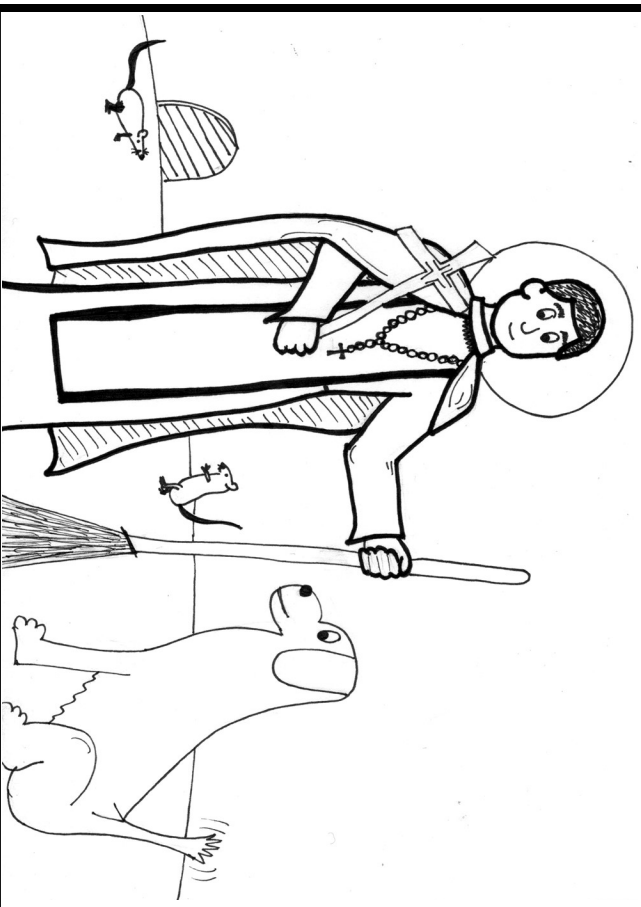

Pray to Saint Martin instead of complaining when it is time to clean your room.



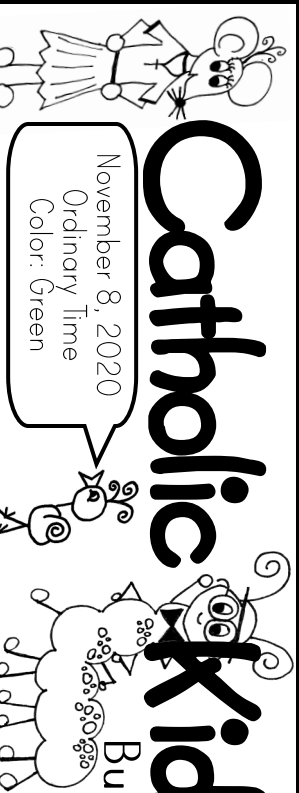

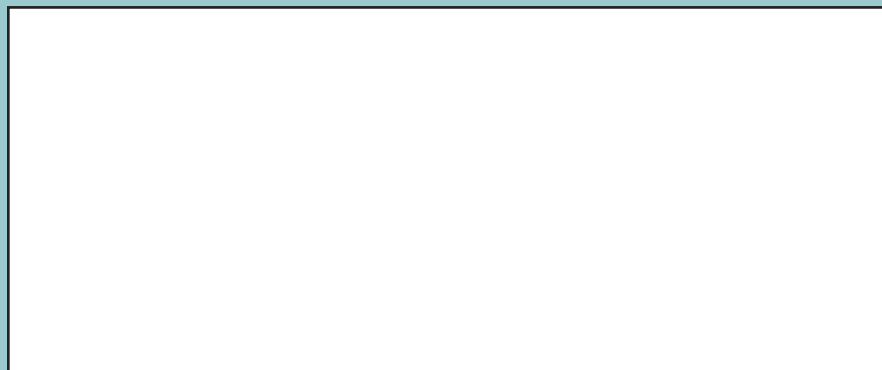
