Happy Easter! This Sunday - the fourth Sunday of Easter - is also called 'Good Shepherd Sunday'. The name is taken from Christ's proclamation 'I am the Good Shepherd' (written in German in the image below).

Though we may intellectually know that Christ is both good and our shepherd, how often we may respond like the proverbial sheep - shying away from His touch or call, wandering outside of His care and directions. How often we fail



to trust in the One who has again and again proven Himself to have the authority to lead us and the care to do so lovingly! I am reminded of a bit of dialogue from C.S. Lewis' The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe when Lucy - at hearing about Aslan (a


Christ-figure in the story) - asks if he is safe.

"Safe?" said Mr. Beaver. "Don't you hear what Mrs. Beaver tells you? Who said anything about safe? 'Course he isn't safe. But he's good. He's the King, I tell you."

Our Good Shepherd isn't 'safe' - He never promised safety! - but He is our good king. Let us more & more entrust ourselves to Him.

April 25 is the feast day of Saint Mark. Inspired by God to write the Gospel of Mark, we are blessed to call him patron of our parish.

Mother's Day Novena

Succinctly, a novena is a nine day period of private or public prayer to obtain special graces or to make special petitions. (The word novena is derived from the Latin *novem*, meaning nine.)

In our liturgical usage, the novena differs from an octave which has a more festive character and precedes or follows an important feast such as Christmas.

The number nine may have its roots in that at the Ascension our Lord gave the Apostles the Great Commission and told them to return to Jerusalem and await the coming of the Holy Spirit, then, nine days later the Holy Spirit descended upon them at Pentecost.

Sunday, May 9 begins our Mother's Day Novena of masses for 2021. Father Maurer will offer these masses for all mothers living and deceased. CLASSICAL EDUCATION IN THEORY

Classical education seeks to recover what has been largely lost; that is, **return** to the original purpose of education.

The classical approach sees the purpose of education as forming human beings for excellent, virtuous living.

Classical education strives to lead students to discover knowledge that is ordered, coherent, integrated, and is rooted in the wisdom of the past, particularly in western civilization.

3 STAGES TO CLASSICAL EDUCATION

The Grammar Stage (K - 3rd grade) – The grammar stage is foundational in classical education. It has an emphasis on memorization and poetry.

The Logic Stage (3rd - 6th grade) – This stage adds a level of depth to the information the student has acquired in the grammar stage and gives the inquiring student the right tools to answer the many questions that arise.

The Rhetoric Stage (7th - 8th grade) — It is during this time that the focus becomes writing and speaking beautifully and persuasively in defense of the integrated truth they have acquired.




