

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Look to your covenant, O Lord, and forget not the life of your poor ones for ever. Arise, O God, and defend your cause, and forget not the cries of those who seek you.

Cf. Ps 74 (73): 20, 19, 22, 23

Jesus says "the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world". The murmuring response of His listeners - 'This saying is hard; who can accept it?' is not unreasonable! The teaching of the Eucharist is shocking: Jesus is commanding us to eat His Body and drink His Blood.

Note Jesus' response when His disciples express their hesitation. He repeats the necessity of consuming His flesh five times!



In contrast, how often we casually receive communion, unthinkingly coming forward, shuffling backing to our seats, aimlessly sitting down to wait for the next thing at Mass. And yet, that host is Jesus' Body - we're chewing and swallowing His flesh & blood.

That this is something with which we might be *comfortable* should be alarming! There is an extraordinary sacrifice, an intimate offering, a literally visceral gift being made. And yet we all too often approach the Eucharist as casually as we pick up a coffee order at Starbucks.

Jesus Himself tells us to 'take and eat', 'take and drink', inviting us to receive such great gifts. In responding, may we approach with great care and reverence.

Reverence at Mass can be an elusive goal. How do I respect and care for the Lord at church?



There are some practical questions we can ask ourselves as we examine our practice of the faith. How do I prepare (if at all) for Mass? What do I set aside (time, clothing, attention) to fully participate in the Mass? How might I give more of myself to the Lord before, during, or after each celebration of Mass?

It may take many small steps, but we can always grow how we show our love to God.

Saint Lawrence, whose memorial we celebrate on August 10, is legendary for both his witness of the true wealth of the Church (the poor!), and the manner of his death. His cheerful words as he was being tortured - 'I'm

well done on this side, turn me over!'
- demonstrate both God's grace and Lawrence's faith.

A deacon himself, he is patron of deacons and the poor. Let us call on his intercession, that we may also devote ourselves to service.

We believe this approach honors the Gospel imperative to resist all that diminishes personal dignity and crushes the human spirit. Instead, we seek to manifest resurrection and the kingdom of heaven on earth. 


