Third Week of Advent: Rejoice in the Lord

"Rejoice in the Lord always," St. Paul exhorts us on this rose-colored Gaudete Sunday. He continues with words of deep consolation: "The Lord is near. Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." As we prepare for the great (and rapidly approaching) feast of the Lord's Nativity, we ask God to enable us "to attain the joys of so great a salvation and to celebrate them always with solemn worship and glad rejoicing" Amid the celebration, the ever-bracing John the Baptist reminds us, in this Sunday's Gospel, to remember the poor: "Whoever has two cloaks should share with the person who has none. 




