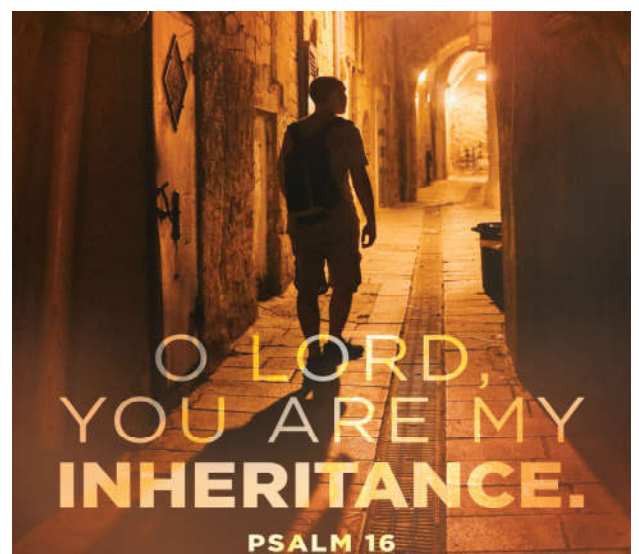

We are very pleased to announce the relaunching of the St. Mark parish Lion's Den, fellowship for men, effective July 9 at 7:15 am in Sullivan Hall.

All parish men are welcome and invited to attend! Yes, 7:15 is early on a Saturday morning, so the trusty coffee maker will be warmed-up and snacks (of some sort) will be available.

Timing may be adjusted as interest and availability evolves. We want to be sure to wrap-up by 9:30 am so participants can attend Saturday daily Mass if they choose.

The basic format is: opening prayer, introductions, Sunday Gospel reading (Lectio Divina - reflection & discussion), weight of the cross (issues of the day and/or what is on our hearts, current challenges, etc.), prayer intentions, then closing prayer.

Deacon Kirk has offered to dedicate the second Saturday of every month (excluding Holy Days) to do a deeper dive into those spiritual matters that the group would like to learn more about. Possible topics are Catechism, Sacraments, Mass, Creed, Pray or particular Gospel/Bible verses, Encyclicals or Vatican documents. Deacon Kirk is also willing to have an Exhibition of the Blessed Sacrament & Benediction in the sanctuary.

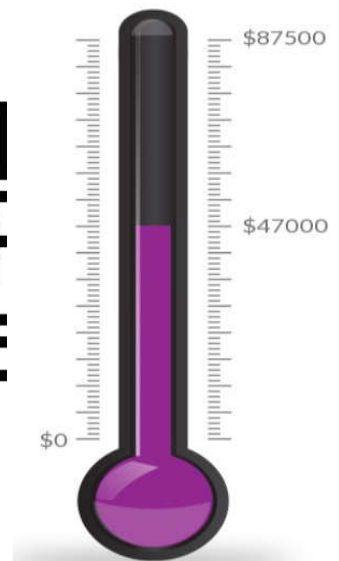
The parish office will be closed on Monday, July 4 in observance of the Independence Day holiday reopening Tuesday, July 5.

There were yummy baking supplies, dried fruit, herbs and spices, fancy cooking oils and even both store bought and home grown fresh produce! The sisters were so surprised and appreciative. 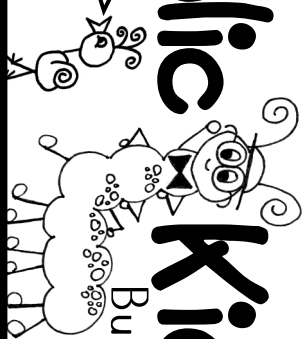

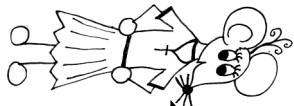

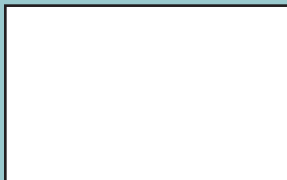
