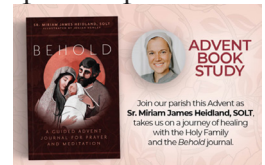

Saint Mark Saint Vincent De Paul Christmas Food Basket Program is back!!

For the first time since Christmas 2019, your Saint Mark Saint Vincent De Paul Society is offering our area neighbors in need a special Christmas Basket meal, home delivered!

We hope to support as many as 60 families in our area, families that often struggle making ends meet at this time of the year, by personally delivering a Christmas Food Basket from our Parish family to theirs.

But we need YOUR help in making this a success!

How can you help?

- ◆ **Sponsor a Family.** Sign up to sponsor one of our area families in need after Masses on November 12th and 13th or after Masses November 19th and 20th. Parishioners who sign up to sponsor a family are asked purchase non-perishable food and household items and a turkey or a ham for a specific family in need in the Shoreline area and drop off the food at the School Gym on Saturday morning on December 17th.
- ◆ **Make a Donation.** Donate to Saint Mark's Saint Vincent De Paul Society to defray our expenses. You can do this at any Mass or by making an online donation at the Parish website or dropping a check off at the Parish offices.
- ◆ **Help Prepare Food Baskets for Delivery.** Join other parishioners on Saturday morning, December 17th to help organize the delivery of the Christmas Meals to the families we are supporting. Volunteering a couple of hours on Saturday morning in the gym is a great way to help.
- ◆ **Deliver a Food Basket.** We need volunteer drivers to personally deliver the food baskets. It takes little more than an hour of your time on Saturday December 17th to deliver a food basket to one or two families.

St. Mark Social Events Team Needs Your Talents!



Want to get to know those sitting in the pew with you? Want to have some fun? St. Mark plans to regularly hold social events where we can make new acquaintances, strengthen existing ones, and enjoy each other's company within a Catholic setting. These events will be planned by a Social Events Team, which you are invited to join (more on this below).

The number and type of events to be held are up to the Social Events Team. Examples might be:

Wine and Wisdom. An evening of social time together with a speaker or video on a topic of interest. Guests share wine and other beverages, and snacks.

Date Night for Couples. Social time with food and beverages, together with a presentation relevant to marriage/ family life. Childcare could be provided to make it easier for parents to attend.

Senior Breakfast/Lunch or Senior Health Class. Social time with food and beverages, together with spiritual topics and topics on Catholic approaches to health and aging.

These are just examples. The actual number, type and location of events will be decided by the Social Events Team.



Want to help? We need 5 to 7 volunteers to serve on the team. The Social Events Team will plan and schedule social events, then ask fellow parishioners to take on leadership roles in making these events happen. WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

The Lord said: I think thoughts of peace and not of affliction. You will call upon me, and I will answer you, and I will lead back your captives from every place.

Cf. Jer 29: 11, 12, 14

Last week and this week see the Church celebrating the dedication of three of the four major basilicas of our faith. The final celebration - that of the basilica of Mary Major (which is to say, Mary, the Mother of God) - is celebrated on August 5th.

All this celebration of earthly church buildings might leave one scratching their heads - especially after hearing Jesus in the Gospel of this Sunday:



“All that you see here - the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will

not be thrown down.”

The Lord is reminding them, and us, that every material good will eventually turn to dust - regardless of their status here on earth. Even more than churches, that reality applies to us, each of whom will someday die.

Jesus goes on to encourage them - and us - to have no fear. Even if we face persecution, as every Christian does!, the Lord will not leave us on our own - it is God who will provide for our defense, our safety, and our eternal reward.

Our earthly efforts are worth continuing, but let us be sure to orient ourselves towards our true home, the heavenly Jerusalem.

In just a couple of weeks, **our new pew missals will arrive!** The [2023 Source & Summit](#) will be our primary resource for Sunday antiphons and readings.



A major shift that you'll notice right away is the move from hymns to antiphons in three places: the entrance procession, the offertory, and the communion procession. We'll go over these before Mass each Sunday to get into the swing of things, but if you'd like to read about the **why** of antiphons, I highly recommend this article by a local Catholic, Thom Rynge: '[Antiphony Reborn: Singing the Mass Propers](#)'

Last week we celebrated the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica (the pope's cathedral). This week we celebrate the [memorial of the dedication of the basilicas of Saint Peter and Saint Paul](#). Though these basilicas are (slightly!) lower in rank to the Lateran basilica, they are nonetheless major sites of prayer and devotion for pilgrims around the world.

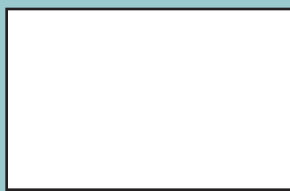

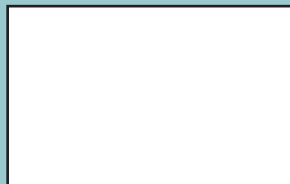
