This unique and beautiful mosaic was sponsored, built and is maintained by Council 11217. The idea for a memorial started over 18 years ago. The final project cost over \$100,000 and is truly a sight to behold as a testimonial to the support of life by Knights of Columbus and our many supporters.

The composition of mosaic tiles allows the entire picture to change with the light, affording the viewer an ongoing change during their meditation, prayer or viewing time.

Many of our supporters, parishioners, friends and family members have purchased memorial pavers in this tranquil garden to support the Knights Pro- Life activities. WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Like newborn infants, you must long for the pure, spiritual milk, that in him you may grow to salvation, alleluia.

Cf. 1 Pt 2: 2

On this last day of the octave of Easter, the Church reflects on the aftermath of Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection in the lives of the Apostles. Having seen the Lord arrested, brutally tortured, and killed they are shaken to their core and in hiding.

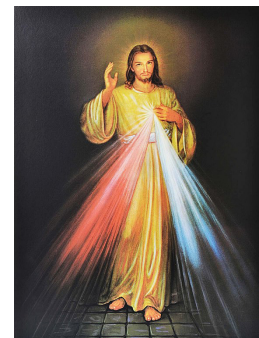
Jesus' appearance in their midst - coming through locked doors, no less - was received joyfully, but it must have been a terrific shock! It is assuredly one of those things that we would say 'you had to be there to believe it!'



And that's exactly where Saint Thomas finds himself. Caravaggio's image *The Incredulity of Saint Thomas* captures his interaction with Jesus so well. Notice how Jesus is grasping Thomas' hand, guiding it *into* His wound, inviting him to see for himself that it truly is Him, the One Whom Thomas dared not believe was alive.

Through this we see that doubt is not sinful, but rather an occasion to draw closer to Jesus! Like Saint Thomas, may we offer Him our doubts, so that He might help us believe.

Today is the **Sunday of Divine Mercy**. The dedication of this Sunday to Divine Mercy was made by Pope John Paul II in 2000. During [his homily for the canonization of Sister Faustina Kowalska](#), he



proclaimed that: "It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday'".

To honor this day, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has [an online collection of notes & quotes for reflection](#).

April 21 is the optional memorial of Saint Anselm, bishop and Doctor of the Church. A Benedictine monk, he became the abbot of the monastery in Bec, Normandy. Some years later, he was named archbishop of Canterbury.

Often credited as a major influence in the rise of Scholasticism, Saint Anselm's dedication to explaining the faith using reason & philosophy led him to be a major influence in helping the Church articulate Herself to the world. [Read more about him at Loyola Press.](#)
