Introduction & Creation

The following parish and school snapshots have been created for use by you and your parish leadership as you discuss and discern potential recommendations for adjustments to the draft parish families. The purpose of their creation is to provide your team with some basic, day-to-day information about the parishes and missions in this draft of your parish family, to better guide your discussion around hopes, concerns, and potential improvements.

The information in these snapshots were pulled from a variety of parish-and-school-reported sources, including:

- Parish Annual Reports and Parish Financial Reports
- Annual Mass Census
- The Archdiocese of Seattle Parish Directory
- Office of Catholic School Reports
- Direct Submissions from Parish Teams

Additionally, to assist with correcting any inaccurate information, outreach was made to each parish and mission providing them the information that would be included in these snapshots for review and updating. We want to thank everyone who reached out to provide updates to the information that they found was incorrect, and we have integrated the updates provided. Please note, for those parishes and missions from which we do not have 2021-2022 FY PARs from, the sacramental and household data that you will see is from the most recent year we do have. All financial information was pulled from 2021-2022 FY financial reports, and Mass Counts were pulled from the 2023 May Mass Census unless otherwise noted.

As the pastoral leaders of your parishes, missions, and schools, we suggest you take some time to familiarize yourself with the information in these snapshots. Additionally, we have provided the Partners in the Gospel FAQ for you to review as well. Our goal is to provide you with the information needed to have informed, prayerful discussions about your draft parish families, so we recommend familiarizing yourself with these materials before sharing them with your staff. Before the September public listening period, we will provide another version of these snapshots that is aimed at a lay audience, less familiar with the financial and administrative side of parish life.
